#### About Shanghai University

Shanghai University is jointly constructed by the Ministry of Education, Shanghai Municipal People's Government, and the State Administration of Science, Technology and Industry for National Defense. In May 1994, the new Shanghai University was built by consolidating Shanghai University of Technology (established in 1960), Shanghai University of Science and Technology (established in 1958), the former Shanghai University, and Shanghai Science & Technology College (established in 1959). The vast faculty and students are determined to inherit and carry forward the glorious tradition of Shanghai University since the 1920s.

Shanghai University is a comprehensive university offering 82 undergraduate programs, 187 graduate programs, and 97 doctoral programs in various disciplines including science, humanities & social sciences, engineering, economics & management, art, etc. Shanghai University currently has 2965 faculty including 677 professors and 1093 associate professors, 14987 graduate students, 20652 undergraduate students, and 4361 international students. Shanghai University also achieved collaboration with 178 universities in 42 nations and regions, managing 5 Confucius Institutes with partners in North America, Europe, Asia, etc.

## Accommodation

## Highlights

### 1. Yu Yuan Garden

Located in Huangpu District of Shanghai, Yu Garden is the private garden of Ming Dynasty. There are City God Temple and various Specialty shops in the garden including Shanghai Chopstick Shop, Umbrella Specialty Shop, Tiehuaxuan Pottery and Porcelain Shop and numerous famous restaurants such as Nanxiang Dumpling Restaurant (Shanghai juicy steamed buns),

Lvbolang Restaurant (Shanghai light refreshments) and Shanghai Old Restaurant (Shanghai style dish).



## **2. Shanghai International Shipping Center Yangshan Deepwater Port**

Yangshan Deep Water Port, located in Shanghai China, ranks as the largest cargo port in the world. Yangshan port is a new port in Hangzhou Bay south of Shanghai. Built to circumvent growth limitations for the Port of Shanghai as a result of shallow waters, it allows berths with depths of up to 15 metres to be built, and is capable of handling the largest container ships today. The port achieves this by building on the offshore islands of Greater and Lesser Yangshan (part of the Zhoushan archipelago), which have been amalgamated by land reclamation and connected to the mainland via the Donghai Bridge, the latter of which was opened on 1 December 2005 as the second-longest ocean bridge in the world at 32.5 km in length. (Hangzhou Bay Bridge in China is the longest sea-crossing bridge in the world at 36 km in length).



### 3.Shanghai Museum

As a museum of ancient Chinese art, Shanghai Museum possesses a collection of 120,000 precious works of art. Its rich and high-quality collection of ancient Chinese bronze, ceramics, painting and calligraphy is specially celebrated in the world.



In 1992, the Shanghai municipal government allocated to the Museum a piece of land at the very center of the city, the People's Square, as its new site. The 29.5 meters high new building has a construction space of 39,200 square meters. Its unique architectural form of a round top with a square base, symbolizing the ancient Chinese philosophy that the square earth is under the round sky, is a distinguished architectural combination of traditional feature and modern spirit. The present Shanghai Museum has eleven galleries and three special temporary exhibition halls. It extends warm welcome to the visitors from all over the world.

#### 4. Shanghai Urban Planning Exhibition Hall

Covering a total floor space of 19,000 square meters, Shanghai Urban Planning Exhibition Center was completed in January, 2000 and opened to the public in Feb 25th of the year. The center offers exhibitions, data searching, study and exchange, education and leisure and sightseeing services. With the theme of "City, Human, Environment and Development," the center has adopted high-tech facilities to display the overall urban planning in Shanghai and its achievements in this regard. This five-story building made of microlite glass, currently known as the world's largest showcase of urban development.
